

Below are some of the common types of bolts.




What's the difference between a screw and a bolt?

Screws have a threaded shaft and are driven into materials without the need for a separate nut, while bolts have a smooth or partially threaded shaft and require a nut for fastening. Screws are commonly used in woodworking and attaching hardware, while bolts are often used in applications that require frequent disassembly or higher strength.




Point & Thread Types

Different fasteners have varying point and thread types. Below are some common ones.




Thread Cutting Screw Point Types

These are the different types of thread cutting screws. Each have a different point for different types of applications.



Head Types

The head of a fastener refers to the bit above the shank or threads. Different types of screws will have different options available for the head style.



Drive Types

The drive of a screw is on the head. It is the drive that a screw driver or bit goes into to install the fastener.




